PHILIP (Charles' dad)

(Spoken in rhythm.) Responsible! Not so fancy-free

(sung) JUST ONCE IN YOUR LIFE I'D LIKE TO SEE YOU TAKE THE BULL BY THE HORN,

(spoken)AND FIND A PROPER MATE

CHARLES:

YOU'RE ASKING A LOT OF ONE WOMAN!

PHILIP:

(Spoken in rhythm) That is the price of the position!

CHARLES:

(Gives his father a negative look.) Excuse me. (walks away)

QUEEN MUM:

(Spoken.) Philip, you are too hard on that boy!

PHILIP:

(Spoken.) He is not a boy. He's a man!

QUEEN:

(Spoken) Philip is right, Mother. (Sung) CHARLES NEEDS TO TAKE A STAND!
